However, please keep the following in mind: **If you have earned a Final Grade of a "D" or "F" in an AP course at the end of the 2018-2019 school year, the Grade Change will be no greater than a "C,"** irrespective of the relative strength of your AP Exam score. It must be understood that signing up for an AP course means you have decided to put forth maximum effort and to strive to complete all required assignments. Thus, failure to meet these expectations, as well as other necessary requirements outlined in your individual course syllabus, will cause you to forfeit this Grade Change opportunity.

*\*Current Seniors - Please Note: Given the submission of Final Transcripts grade Changes will NOT apply to seniors.*

Accordingly, Grade Changes to qualifying students' Final Grades will be entered on or about late August 2019, pursuant to the **subject specific AP Grade Change policies** for courses taken in the 2018-2019 school year at Doral Academy on the backside of this letter.
