These improvements have also introduced a new exam registration and ordering system that will require students to commit to taking the AP exam by October 4, 2019. CollegeBoard believes that this early commitment to the exam will boost the learning culture in AP classrooms. At Doral, students have always committed to the exam from the moment they enrolled in the course. This superb school culture embodied by our school has shown evidence of continued growth and success that rival top schools around the world.

Also new this year, is a change in the CollegeBoard deadline and fee for cancellation of AP Exams. **The final day to cancel an exam without incurring an additional fee is November 15, 2019 at 3pm.** Any student that decides to cancel after this, or does not take the exam, will incur a **\$40 fee to be paid in cash to Mrs. Regalado** in the A building office to cover the cost of the unused exam.
